1.0 Paper Abstracts

The Organiser and 3RD IHOCE 2008 Organising Committee cordially invite scientific, technical, policy and business innovation papers to be presented at the 3RD IHOCE FORUM 2008. Forum abstracts will be published as Forum Proceedings in the Show Directory. Abstracts should not be more than 1,500 words and it should include the following particulars:

- name of author/s
- title
- profile/biography/biodata
- full address of corresponding author
- telephone, facsimile and e-mail

The abstracts should be prepared in:

- A4 sized paper
- typed-single spacing using 12pt Times New Roman font with 2.5cm margins at the top, bottom and sides.
